

TEMPORARY VISITOR POLICY CHANGE

To protect our residents, visitors, and staff and help prevent the spread of the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19), Sunshine Retirement Living has made temporary changes to its Visitor Policy.

Effective immediately, Visitation has been **RESTRICTED**. Visitors will be permitted on a case by case basis for the following reasons:

- 1. End of Life Situations**
- 2. Physician directed medical treatment**
- 3. Special Circumstances as approved by the Executive Director**

All reasons for visiting must be approved by the Executive Director. All Staff and visitors permitted will be screened and not allowed to visit if necessary. These restrictions are consistent with those being implemented across the country, and are as follows:

- Exhibits symptoms of an illness including respiratory infection or the flu
- Has had contact with someone either confirmed or presumptive with a confirmed case of Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19), or with someone who is being tested for Coronavirus or someone who is ill with a respiratory infection
- Has traveled internationally within the last 14 days
- Has taken a cruise or participated in events with more than 1000 people in a confined space within the last 14 days
- Lives in an area where community-based spread of Coronavirus is occurring

To ensure the safety of our residents, Sunshine Retirement Living reserves the right to restrict visitation entirely except for Medically Necessary visitors should the need arise.

Restrictions may change according to the severity of COVID-19 and we will continue to keep you informed.

Hand washing remains the best way to prevent the transmission of any infections or viruses.
