Oscar: Well, here at home and new at this hour, vaccinations set for tomorrow at an assisted living center in Pharr. Residents and employees at Gardens at Brooke Ridge Assisted Living and Memory Care will get vaccinated. That facility has 120 doses. The Gardens was among the first to enroll in the CDC's National Vaccination Program for Longterm Care Facilities.
