

Meghan Schiller: At our local nursing homes, it's a daily fight to lock out the virus. Miraculously, the Haven at North Hills reports no current cases. Still, the facility is among the first to enroll in the CDC's National COVID-19 Vaccine Program.

Dr. Rob Potter: I was very excited and my wife was very excited.

Meghan Schiller: Dr. Rob Potter tells me his mother-in-law is 101 years old, an age that he says earns her priority access. The CDC would partner with CVS and Walgreens to provide free onsite vaccination clinics [00:00:30] as soon as the vaccine can ship out.

Jennifer Gross: So once we get the green light, they will give the Haven at North Hills a call. They will schedule the time to arrive. They will come out for the dose and we'll be on our way to welcoming families and have a big reunion.

Meghan Schiller: The Health and Human Services Secretary today, seeing that Pfizer will have its FDA hearings scheduled December 10th, and it could be approved within days of that hearing. Moderna will have its FDA hearing currently on December 17th, [00:01:00] meaning if the FDA deems both of them safe, we could have a vaccine as early as Christmas.
